### MATES IN CONSTRUCTION NT:

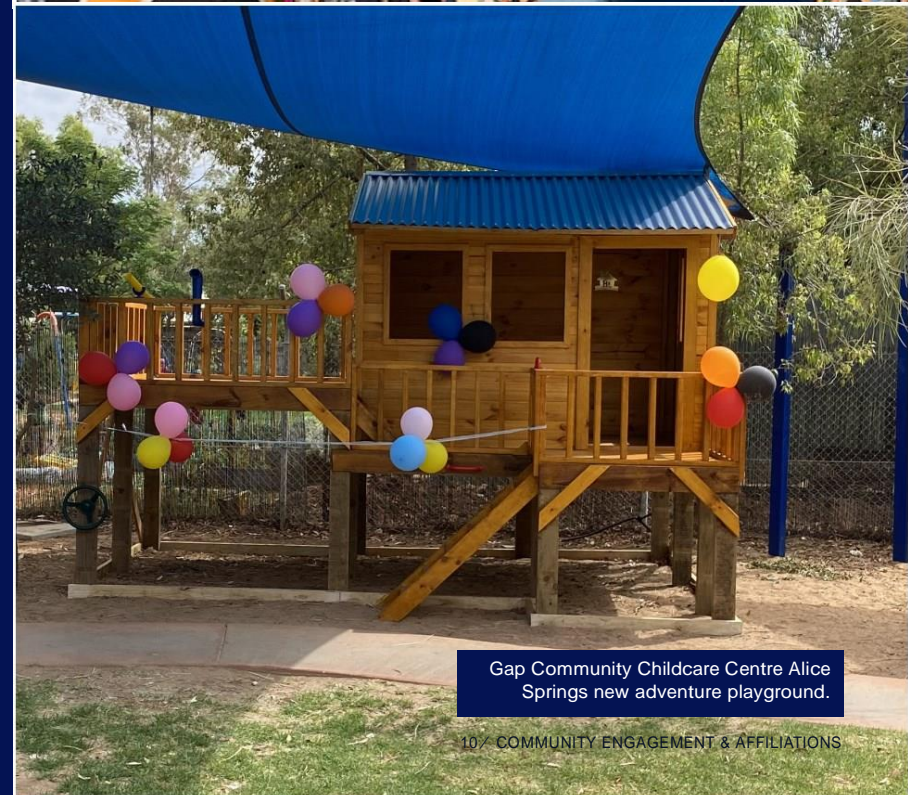
We are proud to be an industry partner of Mates in Construction NT. The organisation works hard to educate construction workers to reduce the rates of suicide in our industry.

Every year 190 Australian's working in the construction industry take their own lives; this means we lose a construction worker every second day to suicide.

Construction workers are six times more likely to die from suicide than an accident at work. We take these statistics seriously. As such we have provided General Awareness Training for all our staff through Mates in Construction, and will provide further training opportunities for them via the Connector and Assist courses.
